This class will satisfy the 9s inspection criteria as specified by the North Carolina Administrative Code. The primary objective of the course is to inform current and future chief officers of the various aspects and complexities surrounding the operations and organization of North Carolina fire departments. Emphasis will be placed on ratings and inspections, NFIRS reporting, prevention and grant programs, basic line-of-duty death information, financial considerations, and an overview of the various expectations facing a chief officer.

The Chief 101 course became a requirement in 2010 with the upgrades required as follows:

- Cycle 2010 – 2014 (initial course one year after appointment as the Chief).
- Cycle 2015 – 2019 (course upgrade).
- Cycle 2020 – 2024 (course upgrade).

If someone missed the upgrade 2015 – 2019 , the entire Chief 101 course will need to be completed.
